Dear Trinity Families,

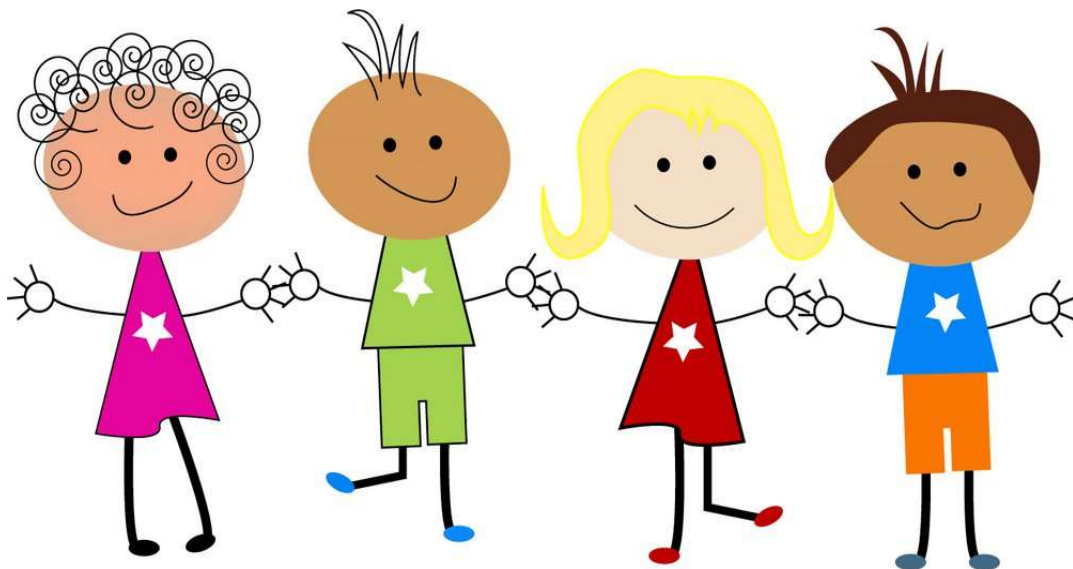
