

# FRIDAY FANFARE

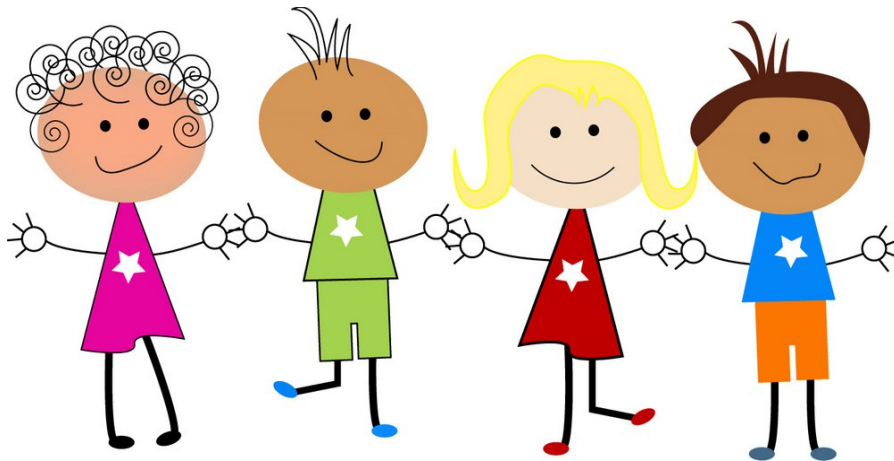

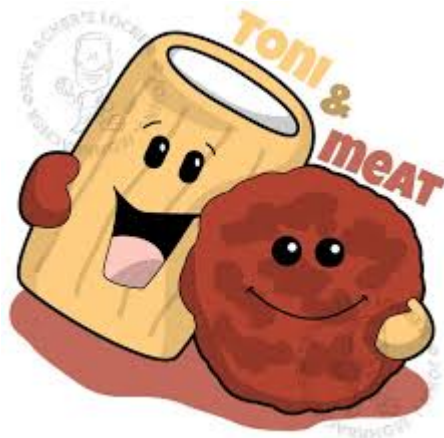
